When recognized, please begin by providing your name and address for the record (optional). Anyone wishing to submit written information at the meeting needs to furnish ten (10) copies to the City Clerk in advance to allow for distribution to City Council, staff, and the media. Willful disruption of the meeting shall not be permitted. If the Mayor finds that there is in fact willful disruption of any City Council Meeting, he/she may order the disrupting parties out of the room and subsequently conduct the City’s business without them present.

SUMMARY:

Staff have reviewed the Municipal Code relating to the City's Business License process. A number of amendments are proposed to align the Municipal Code with the existing process as well as provide clarifying language regarding the issuance of permits. Likewise, it is the desire to rescind a prior amendment relating to permits. The proposed amendments make the following changes:

1. Identify the Finance Department as the designated department for the processing and issuance of business licenses. This is consistent with the current process and is modified by removing the City Clerk as the designated department.
2. Clarifies that all business license applications require the review and approval of the Community Development Director or designee. This is to ensure that all businesses are operating consistent with the City's zoning and use regulations.
3. Provides clarifying language to ensure applicants secure proper permits to conduct their business in accordance with the City's zoning and land use regulations.
4. Ordinance 11-2024 established a fee schedule for business licenses issued for Animal Confinement/Breeding/Raising. Following review of the ordinance with legal counsel, it has been advised to repeal this ordinance and subsequent sections.

The Council introduced the ordinance and held first reading on August 27, 2025.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The changes do not result in any change in fiscal revenue.

ORDINANCE NO. 8-2025

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCFARLAND AMENDING CHAPTER 5.04 OF THE MCFARLAND MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO BUSINESS LICENSES

Section 1. Recitals

WHEREAS, the City of McFarland desires to amend, clarify and codify its Municipal Code related to Business Licenses;

WHEREAS, this ordinance amendment updates Municipal Code section 5.04;

WHEREAS, adoption of this Ordinance is in furtherance of the City's goals and objectives while reducing the potentially negative impacts arising from deficient and/or incomplete/incompatible Municipal Code Chapters.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MCFARLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.04.045 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Section 5.04.060 is amended as follows:

5.04.060 Exemptions.

A. Nothing in this chapter shall be deemed or construed to apply to any person transacting and carrying on any business exempt by virtue of the constitution or applicable statutes of the United States or of the state from the payment of such taxes as are prescribed in this chapter.

B. None of the license taxes provided for by this chapter shall be so applied as to occasion an undue burden on interstate commerce. In any case where a license tax is believed by a licensee or applicant for a license to place an undue burden upon such commerce, he may apply to the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** for an adjustment of the tax so that it will not be discriminatory or unreasonable as to such commerce. Such application may be made before, at, or within six months after payment of the prescribed license tax. The applicant shall, by affidavit and supporting testimony, show his method of business and the gross volume or estimated gross volume of business and such other information as the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** may deem necessary in order to determine the extent, if any, of such undue burden on such commerce. The ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** shall then conduct an investigation, and, after having first obtained the written approval of the city attorney, shall fix as the license tax for the applicant, an amount that is reasonable and nondiscriminatory, or if the license tax has already been paid, shall order a refund of the amount over and above the license tax so fixed. In

fixing the license tax to be charged, the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** shall have the power to base the license tax upon any measure which will ensure that the license tax assessed shall be uniform with that assessed on businesses of like nature, so long as the amount assessed does not exceed the license tax as prescribed by this chapter. Any person claiming an exemption pursuant to this section shall file a verified statement with the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** stating the facts upon which the exemption is claimed. The ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** shall, upon a proper showing contained in the verified statement, issue a license to such person claiming exemption under this section without payment to the city of the license tax required by this chapter. The ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department**, after giving notice and a reasonable opportunity for hearing to a licensee, may revoke any license granted pursuant to the provisions of this section upon information that the licensee is not entitled to the exemption as provided in this section.

Section 3. Section 5.04.070 is amended as follows:

5.04.070 Application, approval and contents of license.

- A. Every person required to have a license under the provisions of this chapter shall make application for the same to the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** of the city. Such application shall be made upon a form provided by the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** and shall set forth such information as may be required by the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** as necessary to determine properly the amount of the license to paid.
- B. All applications shall be reviewed **and approved** by the city of McFarland Community Development Director or his/her **designee prior to issuance by the Finance Department**. All required planning entitlements and permits must be obtained by the applicant prior to approval of a business license application.
- C. Each business license issued hereunder shall be conditioned upon the following and each licensee shall comply with same:
1. All written conditions or limitations imposed upon the permit;
 2. Payment of all fees required by this chapter;
 3. Cooperating with the police department and all other departments of the city in connection with the investigation of any criminal activity in or around the business premises and to assist in the investigation thereof;
 4. The business and premises on which it is conducted shall not be in violation of any local, state, or federal laws or regulations including, without limitation, all laws, rules and regulations within the McFarland Municipal Code. **For nonconforming uses, please refer to MMC Chapter 17.137 Non-Conforming Uses. For any conflict arising between business type and Municipal Code provisions, a Conditional Use Permit shall be sought. For Conditional Use Permit, please refer to MMC Chapter 17.152.**
- D. A business license shall not be issued or renewed if the property owner or business owner has any outstanding zoning, code enforcement and/or building violations on the subject property.
- E. Upon approval of the business license application and upon the payment of the prescribed license tax the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** shall issue to such person a license which shall contain (i) the name of the person to whom the license is issued, (ii) the business licensed, (iii) the place where such business is to be transacted and carried on, (iv) the date of the expiration of the license, and (v)

such other information as may be necessary for the enforcement of the provisions of this chapter.

Section 4. Section 5.04.080 is amended as follows:

5.04.080 Appeal.

Any person aggrieved by any decision of the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** with respect to the issuance, refusal, to issue such license may appeal to the council by filing a notice of appeal with the city clerk. The council shall thereupon fix a time and place of hearing such appeal. The city clerk shall give notice to such person of the time and place of hearing by serving it personally or by depositing it in the U.S. Post Office at McFarland, California, postage prepaid, addressed to such person at his last known address. The council shall have authority to determine all questions raised on such appeal. No such determination shall conflict with any substantive provision of this chapter.

Section 5. Section 5.04.100 is amended as follows:

5.04.100 Duplicate license.

A duplicate license may be issued by the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** to replace any license previously issued under this chapter which has been lost or destroyed upon the licensee filing a statement of such fact, and at the time of filing such statement, paying to the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** a duplicate license fee of fifteen dollars.

Section 6. Section 5.04.130 is amended as follows:

5.04.130 Penalty for failure to pay tax when due.

For failure to pay a license tax when due, the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** shall add a penalty of twenty-five percent of the license tax on the last day of the month after the due date thereof and the penalty and license tax shall bear interest from and after the due date until paid at the rate of twenty-five percent for each month delinquent thereafter providing that the amount of any penalty shall in no event exceed one hundred percent of the amount of the license tax due.

Section 7. Section 5.04.200 is amended as follows:

5.04.200 Enforcement.

It shall be the duty of the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** of the city and ~~he who~~ is by the ordinance codified in this section, directed to enforce each and all of the provisions of this chapter, and the chief of police shall render such assistance in the enforcement of this chapter as may from time to time be required by the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department** or the city council. The ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Department**, in the exercise of the duties imposed upon him under this chapter, shall examine or cause to be examined all places of business in the city to ascertain whether the provisions of this chapter have been complied with. The ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Director**, each and all of his assistants, and any police officer shall have the power and authority to enter, free of charge, and at any reasonable time, any place of business required to be licensed in this chapter, and demand an exhibition of its license. Any person having such license theretofore issued, in his possession or under his control, who willfully fails to

exhibit the same on demand shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to the penalties provided by this chapter. It shall be the duty of the ~~city clerk~~ **Finance Director** to cause a complaint to be filed against any and all persons found to be violating any of the provisions of this chapter.

Section 8. Section A of Chapter 5.04.140 as added by Ordinance No. 11-2024 is repealed in its entirety.

Section 9. Section A of Chapter 5.04.140 is amended as follows:

Arts and/or crafts fair \$10.00 per both/stall, **per day**

Pop-up vendor — non-food single event \$10 per booth/stall, per day

Section 10. Notice. The City clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance to be posted within 15 days after its passage, in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code.

Section 11. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Ordinance is, for any reason, deemed or held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, or preempted by legislative enactment, such decision or legislation shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council of the City of McFarland hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or word thereof, regardless of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, clauses, phrases, or word might subsequently be declared invalid or unconstitutional or preempted by subsequent legislation.

Section 12. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty days after its adoption pursuant to California Government Code section 36937.

Section 13. Publication. The City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published or posted according to law.

SUMMARY:

The applicant, Steve Milicic, and owner of APN: 060-420-20 is requesting the cancelation of a 39.09-acre parcel that is subject to Williamson Act Land Use Contract, which was recorded on January 30, 1968, in book 4491 page 463 of the Official Records. The applicant submitted a non-renewal that was processed by staff and recorded. The parcel was annexed in 2024 through Annexation 19 and was pre-zoned R-1, R-2, R-4, and Estate. At the time of annexation, the applicant submitted a Master Plan for the same 38.18 ac parcel. Applicant is completing the project in phases and is starting with the adjacent properties. Their Tentative Tract Map proposal for the adjacent property is required to include a park. The park and sump is being proposed on the property under the Williamson Act Land Use Contract and therefore it is required that the applicant complete a Petition for Cancellation of Land Conservation.

California Government Code Section 51282(a) states your Board may grant tentative approval of cancellation of a contract only if one of the following findings is made:

1. That the cancellation is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 7;
2. That the cancellation is in the public interest.

For the purpose of clarification, Chapter 7 of the Government Code is the California Land Conservation Act of 1965 and is referred to as the Williamson Act. The California Land Conservation Act was enacted to guarantee the future agricultural use of what is considered to be the State's best agricultural land and contains certain provisions of eligibility. In exchange for enrolling property into the Williamson Act, landowners are entitles to a reduction in taxes in order to guarantee the continued use of the land for agricultural purposes.

The applicants assert that approval of the cancellation request is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 7 and, therefore, is in accordance with California Government Code Section 51282(a)(1).

In order for your Board to approve the cancellation under the referenced provision, the following findings must be made pursuant to California Government Code Section 51282(b):

1. The cancellation is for land on which a notice of nonrenewal has been served pursuant to Section 51245;
 - a. The Notice of non-renewal was made on July 28, 2025.
2. The cancellation is not likely to result in the removal of adjacent lands from agricultural use;
 - a. Surrounding properties, including those adjacent, are not what resulted in the cancellation request. The property was initially land that was used for agriculture, but the property owner has gradually stopped using it for agriculture use. The owner's goal was to build residential homes for investment and business purposes. The property was part of Annexation 19 where it was pre-zoned R-1, R-2, R-4, and Estates.
3. The cancellation is for an alternative use which is consistent with the applicable provisions of the McFarland General Plan;
 - a. The property was part of Annexation 19 where it was pre-zoned R-1, R-2, R-4, and Estates. Property is consistent with the General Plan. The land use for the property is Single-Family Residential, Multi-family Residential, and Estates.
4. The cancellation will not result in discontinuous patterns of urban development; and
 - a. Development in McFarland has sprawled out to the urban areas surrounding the City. This can be reflected in the most recent Annexations. We have multiple residential and commercial developments going out towards South Garzoli, including a new school, and commercial project proposals. That being said, a discontinuous pattern of development will not be a result of the cancellation.
5. There is no proximate noncontracted land which is available and suitable for the use proposed on the contracted land or that development of the contract land would provide more contiguous patterns of urban development than development of proximate noncontracted land.
 - a. The property owner is Steven Milicic. Their goal is to sell the properties to developers for the construction of residential neighborhoods of varying sizes. Some of the developers who have supplied the applicant with letters of intent are developers who intend to build affordable homes and will be partnering with programs to make that possible. Their purpose is consistent with the General Plan and Housing Element and will not create a discontinuous pattern of development as a result.

WHEREAS, the findings was made that the cancellation is not likely to result in the removal of

adjacent lands from agricultural use; and

WHEREAS, City Council and staff has found that the five (5) elements in Chapter 7 of the California Government Code Section 51282(a) have been met; and

WHEREAS, the finding was made that the cancellation is for an alternative use which is consistent with the applicable provisions of the McFarland General Plan; and

WHEREAS, the finding was made that the cancellation will not result in discontinuous patterns of urban development; and

WHEREAS, the finding was made that there is no proximate non-contracted land which is available and suitable for the use proposed on the contracted land or that development of the contract land would provide more contiguous patterns of urban development than development of proximate non-contracted land; and

WHEREAS, said applications have been made in the form and manner prescribed by Title 17 Zoning of the McFarland Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State Guidelines Section 15162(a) the lead agency has determined the Initial Study/Negative Declaration that was completed for Annexation 19 to adequately identify any environmental impacts of the Project as reflected in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, through its clerk, did set Wednesday, September 24th, 2025 at the hour of 6:00 pm in the Council Chambers located at 103 W. SUMMARY:

On June 27, 2025, the City Clerk received a Notice of Intent to Circulate a Petition and proposed initiative measure ("Measure") on behalf of proponents of the Measure. If approved, the Measure would prohibit Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) from operating in the City of McFarland and provide a timeframe for any existing CAFOs to cease operations.

The initiative process is governed by the California Elections Code. Pursuant to the Code, the City Attorney timely prepared and sent a ballot title and summary of the Measure to the City Clerk. Elections Code provides the proponents six (6) months from the receipt of the ballot title and summary to gather enough signatures to qualify the Measure for the ballot.

On August 13, 2025, the proponents submitted a signed petitions to the City Clerk. The petitions were transferred to the Kern County Registrar of Voters to verify the validity of the petition signatures.

On September 5, 2025, the City received official notification from the County Registrar of Voters that the petition contains 656 valid signatures, which exceeds the 509 signatures needed to place the measure on the ballot. Pursuant to the Elections Code, the Measure has demonstrated the requisite sufficiency to qualify for the ballot. Therefore, a Certificate of Sufficiency of Initiative Petition is attached with a recommendation that the Council receive and accept the Certificate.

SUBJECT: CITY COUNCIL TAKE MINISTERIAL AND MANDATORY ACTION AS
REQUIRED UNDER ELECTION CODE SECTIONS 1405 AND 9215
REGARDING THE CITIZENS-SPONSORED INITIATIVE PROCESS

SUMMARY:

On June 27, 2025, the City Clerk received a Notice of Intent to Circulate a Petition and proposed initiative measure from Jorge Mendoza on behalf of proponents of the initiative measure. If approved, the initiative measure would prohibit Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) from operating in the City of McFarland and provide a timeframe for any existing CAFOs to cease operations (“Measure”).

California Constitution article II, §§ 8-11, provides the basis for the initiative power in California. An initiative is “the power of the electors to propose statutes and amendments to the Constitution and to adopt or reject them.” (Cal. Const art II, §8(a).) The initiative power also extends to cities and counties. “Initiative and referendum powers may be exercised by the electors of each city or county under procedures that the Legislature shall provide.” (Cal Const art II, §11(a).)

In reviewing initiatives, California courts have consistently held that it is “the duty of the courts to jealously guard the right of the people.” (*Martin v. Smith* (1959) 176 Cal. App. 2d 117, 117.) Voter action by initiative is so fundamental that it is described “not as a right granted the people, *but as a power reserved by them.*” (*Associated Home Builders etc., Inc. v City of Livermore* (1976) 18 Cal. 3d 582, 591)(emphasis added.)

As such, the City Council’s duty to adopt a qualified voter-sponsored initiative or place it on the ballot (as discussed in greater detail below), is ministerial and mandatory. (*Native American Sacred Site and Environmental Protection Association et al, v. City of San Juan Capistrano* (2004) 120 Cal. App. 4th 961, 966.)

The statutory procedures for city initiatives are governed by California Election Code sections 9200 to 9226. The initiative process begins with a filing with the City Clerk and a notice of intent to circulate a petition, together with the text of the initiative. (Election Code § 9202(a).) Here, the petition and Measure were received at the end of June.

Soon after, the City Attorney timely prepared and sent a ballot title and summary of the Measure to the City Clerk, consistent with the requirements of Election Code section 9203.

The Election Code provides the proponents six (6) months from the receipt of the ballot title and summary to gather enough signatures to qualify the Measure for the ballot.

On August 13, 2025, the proponents submitted a signed petition to the City Clerk. The petitions were transferred to the Kern County Elections Division ("County") to verify the validity of the petition signatures.

On September 5, 2025, the City received official notification from the County that the petition contains 656 valid signatures, which exceeds the 509 signatures required to qualify the Measure on the ballot. Consistent with the requirements of Elections Code section 9210, the Measure has demonstrated the requisite sufficiency to qualify for the ballot.

Because the Measure has obtained the required number of signatures and qualified for the ballot, and a Certificate of Sufficiency of Initiative has been received and accepted. As such, Election Code section 9215 provides the City Council with the following options:

1. Adopt the Measure, without alteration, at this meeting or at meeting within 10 days of the acceptance of the Certificate of Sufficiency of Initiative.
2. Pursuant to Election Code section 1405, submit the Measure to the voters at the next General Election, which will be on November 3, 2026 (Option No. 2 Resolution 2025-133)
3. Pursuant to Election Code section 1405, submit the Measure to the voters at a special municipal election occurring on a Tuesday between 88 and 103 days after the City Council calls for the special election, which if ordered, would be either December 23 or December 30. While there is a special election scheduled for November 4, 2025, the County informed City staff that there is not sufficient time to put the Measure on the ballot for the upcoming statewide special election (Option No. 3 Resolution 2025-133)
4. Direct staff to prepare an impartial and informational report analyzing the impact of the Measure on the City (Option 4 Resolution 2025-133). Staff must present the report no later than 30 days after the City certifies that the petition is sufficient. After the report is presented to the City Council, the City Council must either vote to adopt the Measure or order an election.

Environmental Impact

If the City Council adopts the Measure or submits the Measure to the voters, both actions are ministerial decisions and not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"). "When the electorate undertakes to exercise the reserved legislative power, the city has no discretion and acts as the agent for the electorate. In such event, the enactment of the initiative measure is excluded from CEQA compliance." (*Northwood Homes, Inc. v. Town of Moraga* (1989) 216 Cal.App.3d 1197, 1206.)

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

If the City Council chooses either Options #2 or #3, the City will be responsible for the elections costs estimated at \$38,000.

RECOMMENDATION:

City Council review options and take action as required by Election Code.

INITIATIVE MEASURE TO BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO THE VOTERS

The City Attorney has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

PROHIBITION OF CONFINED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATIONS

The initiative asks voters to add new sections to Chapter 17 of the McFarland Municipal Code to phase-out existing and prohibit future Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFO) in all zone districts within the City limits of the City of McFarland. Existing operations would become legal nonconforming and have two years to phase out or modify operations to come into compliance. The proposed ordinance exempts certain temporary stables used during emergencies. ● The proposed ordinance would define CAFO in accordance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System. The animals covered would be cattle or cow/calf pairs, mature dairy cattle, veal calves, swine, horses, sheep or lambs, turkeys, chickens, laying hens or broilers, and ducks. CAFOs would be categorized as large, medium, or small, depending on the number and type of confined animals and potential to impact water quality. The proposed ordinance would consider animals confined if stabled or confined and fed or maintained for a total of 45 days or more in any 12-month period, and when crops, vegetation, forage growth, or post-harvest residues are not sustained in the normal growing season over any portion of the lot or facility. Two or more operations could together be considered a single CAFO if certain criteria are met. ● The proposed ordinance would require registration for existing CAFOs, which would have two years to modify or cease operations. It would require the City Manager or his/her designee to present an annual report on ordinance compliance to the City Council. ● If a farm meets the definition of a CAFO and does not comply with the terms of the proposed ordinance by the end of the phase-out period, then the farm would face daily penalties of \$1,000 for the first day, \$5,000 for the second day, and \$10,000 for the third and subsequent days in violation. The City could additionally pursue any other enforcement available at law. The measure also provides a private right of action for injunctive relief and attorneys' fees and costs to the prevailing party. It would make it a misdemeanor to retaliate against another person for making a good-faith complaint.

PROHIBITION ON CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATIONS (CAFOs)

The People of the City of McFarland ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

That Chapter 17.200 Prohibition on Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) be added to Title 17 Zoning of the McFarland Municipal Code as follows:

Chapter 17.200 Prohibition on Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs)

17.200.010 Findings

- A. The residents of the City of McFarland value healthy communities including having safe drinking water.
- B. The State of California Water Quality Control Board adopted guidelines and regulations to provide for the control and reduction of salt and nitrates from degrading water quality within the Central Valley.
- C. In February of 2025, the Central Valley Water Quality Control Board conditionally approved the Kern Water Collaborative Early Action Plan (Early Action Plan) as one of the cornerstones of the Nitrate Control Program
- D. The Early Action Plan identifies Disadvantaged Communities as areas that lack adequate financial

resources to treat for nitrate and other contaminants.

- E. The Early Action Plan identifies Confined Animal Feeding Operations as a specific source of nitrate production within the planning area.
- F. Existing Confined Animal Feeding Operations within the City limits of the City of McFarland are permitted by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board to house 3,553 animal equivalent units at the facility.
- G. Existing Confined Animal Feeding Operations within the City limits of the City of McFarland produce 14.7 million gallons of wastewater annually which contain high levels of nitrates and salts.
- H. The residents of the City of McFarland have experienced increase levels of nitrates in the drinking water system.
- I. The City of McFarland has taken steps to mitigate the increased nitrate levels on a temporary basis.
- J. The residents of the City of McFarland desire to reduce nitrate producing sources within the City limits of the City of McFarland.

17.200.020 Purpose.

The Purpose of this Section is to protect the environment and the health and well-being of McFarland residents and communities by prohibiting the operation of CAFOs, as defined herein, within the city

limits of the City of McFarland.

17.200.030 Definitions.

The following words and phrases as used in this Chapter shall be defined as follows:

“Animal feeding operation” or **“AFO”** means a lot or facility that meets the regulatory definition of an AFO as set out by the Environmental Protection Agency in 40 CFR 122.23 as of August 2023. Specifically, a lot or facility (other than an aquatic animal production facility) is deemed an AFO where the following conditions are met:

- (i) Animals (other than aquatic animals) have been, are, or will be stabled or confined and fed or maintained for a total of 45 days or more in any 12-month period, and
- (ii) Crops, vegetation, forage growth, or post-harvest residues are not sustained in the normal growing season over any portion of the lot or facility.

“Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation” or **“CAFO”** means an AFO which meets the definition of a Small CAFO, Medium CAFO or Large CAFO, as defined herein, and set out by the Environmental Protection Agency in 40 CFR 122.23 as of August 2023, or which is designated as a CAFO of any size by the permitting authority.

“Large CAFO” means an AFO which confines at least the number of animals described in Table 17-0.

“Medium CAFO” means an AFO which falls within the size range in Table 18-0 and either:

- (i) has a man-made ditch or pipe that carries manure or wastewater to surface water; or
- (ii) the animals come into contact with surface water that passes through the area where they’re confined; or
- (iii) is designated as a Medium CAFO by the permitting authority due to being a significant contributor of pollutants.

“Pre-Existing CAFO” means a CAFO currently in existence in City of McFarland at the time this Ordinance becomes effective.

“Small CAFO” means an AFO which confines fewer than the number of animals listed in Table 17-0 and which has been designated as a CAFO by the permitting authority as a significant contributor of pollutants.

17.200.040 Aggregation.

Two or more lots or facilities that collectively meet the definition of a CAFO shall together be deemed a CAFO if they are under common ownership and are either on adjoining parcels or share a waste disposal system.

17.200.050 Prohibition of CAFOs; Exceptions.

1. No person shall establish, operate, expand, or maintain a CAFO in the City of McFarland on or after the date of the enactment of this Section.
2. This Section does not limit or impact the availability of remedies under other applicable local, state and federal laws, regulations, and ordinances, including but not limited to laws, regulations, and ordinances regarding environmental protection and animal cruelty.
3. The prohibitions in this Section shall not apply to an evacuation area set up to temporarily stable animals in the case of a natural disaster or a declared state of emergency, or to a registered non-profit animal shelter, sanctuary, or rescue organization which does not sell animals or animal products.

17.200.060 Existing CAFOs; Phase-Out Period.

1. Notwithstanding anything in this Section, Pre-Existing CAFOs shall be deemed a nonconforming use and shall be required to register on a public database maintained by the City of McFarland.
2. Pre-Existing CAFOs shall be given a phase-out period of no more than twenty-four (24) months from the effective date of this Section to terminate their operations. Proof of this shall be provided to the City of McFarland prior to the end of the phase-out period. During the phase-out period, Pre-Existing CAFOs shall not increase the number of animals in confinement.
3. The City Manager or his/her designee shall inspect closed CAFOs within one month of receiving such proof of termination from a Pre-Existing CAFO to ensure that all relevant operations have ceased or been appropriately terminated.

4. Any Pre-Existing CAFO may apply to the City of McFarland for ninety (90) day extensions beyond the phase-out period identified in section E-2, provided that no more than two (2) extension periods are granted. The extensions would be in the form of a Conditional Use Permit and would include plans and phases for the termination of the pre-existing CAFO and may include the payment of exactions as determined by the City Council.

17.200.070 Violations.

1. Any person who continues to operate a Pre-Existing CAFO after the one (1) year phase-out period elapses (or any extension as provided in E4), or who establishes or maintains a CAFO following the enactment of this Section, or who violates any other provision of this Section, shall be subject to a civil penalty of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the first offense, five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the second offense, and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the third and any subsequent offenses, payable to the City of McFarland General Fund.
2. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City Manager or his/her designee may also pursue on behalf of the city any other civil or administrative penalty or remedy otherwise available for failure to comply with the requirements of this Section.
3. Each day, or portion thereof, during which the violation occurs shall be treated as a separate offense.
4. Nothing herein shall impact the standing of other interested parties, or the availability of remedies under other applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including the remedies afforded by any person set forth in Subsection I of this Ordinance.
5. For the purposes of this Subsection (F), "person" includes any owner, officer, or director of a CAFO. No penalties shall be issued to individuals solely for working at a CAFO operation unless they also meet one of the foregoing criteria.

17.200.080 Annual Report.

The City Manager or his/her designee shall prepare an annual report containing the following information: the number of CAFOs currently operating in City of McFarland; the number of CAFO termination notices received in the previous year; the number of CAFO termination inspections conducted in the previous year; the number of CAFO workers in the retraining program; and the amount of penalties assessed and collected in the previous year. Such report shall be presented to the City Council at a duly-noticed public hearing and posted on the City's webpage, beginning one year after the effective date of this Section and continuing until all CAFOs, as defined herein, have been phased out of the City.

17.200.090 Right of Action.

Any interested party may institute a civil proceeding for injunctive relief against a violation of this Section, and for whatever other additional relief the court deems appropriate. In any action brought

pursuant to this Section, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs. The remedies available under this Section shall be in addition to, and shall not in any way restrict, any other rights or remedies under law. Nothing in this Section is intended to, or shall be interpreted to, conflict with the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of the State of California, or with any state or federal law. For the purposes of this Section, "interested party" shall include but not be limited to any association, organization, society, or corporation organized for the purpose of protecting animals or the environment.

17.200.100 Retaliation Prohibited.

Any person who retaliates against another person for making a good-faith complaint that there has been a failure to comply with this Section is guilty of a misdemeanor.

17.200.110 Severability.

The provisions of this Section are declared to be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or portion of this Section, or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Section, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances. In the event that any provision is severed, the remaining provisions of this Section shall be interpreted in light of its stated purpose and intent.

SECTION 2. FUTURE AMENDMENTS.

In addition to the foregoing, the City Council shall amend the City Municipal Code as needed within a reasonable time following the adoption of the Ordinance to effectuate this Ordinance, and from time-to-time as the necessity of any other amendments becomes clear.

SECTION 3. CONSTRUCTION & INTERPRETATION.

This Ordinance and its provisions shall be broadly construed and interpreted to accomplish its purpose and intent.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance, or part thereof, or the application of any provision or part to any person or circumstance is held for any reason to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions and parts shall not be affected, and the Ordinance as a whole shall be interpreted in light of its stated Purpose and Intent. The People of the City of McFarland hereby declare that they would have passed this Ordinance and every section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the voters, or as soon as otherwise allowable under applicable law.

SECTION 8. CERTIFICATION; PUBLICATION.

Upon approval by the voters, the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published according to law.

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2025, a Notice of Intention to circulate a petition for an ordinance initiative entitled "Prohibition on Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations" ("Initiative") was submitted to the City, and

WHEREAS, on August 13, 2025, the City Clerk delivered the Initiative Petition to the Kern County Registrar of Voters ("Registrar") for signature verification, and

WHEREAS, on September 5, 2025, the Registrar returned a Certificate to Initiative Petition regarding the Initiative Petition verifying the signatures using process authorized by the California Election Code, and

WHEREAS, on September 24, 2025, the City Council accepted the Certificate of Sufficiency (“Certificate”) presented by the City Clerk as to the sufficiency of the Initiative Petition, and

WHEREAS, Elections Code section 9212 authorizes the City Council to refer an initiative measure to City agencies for a report regarding eight (8) delineated categories of impact;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined a section 9212 report would provide valuable information regarding the execution of its mandatory and ministerial duties under Elections Code section 9215 regarding the Measure, as well as to interested City residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of McFarland does hereby order, pursuant to its right and authority under Elections Code section 9212 as follows:

SECTION 1. City Staff to prepare a Report pursuant to Elections Code section 9212.

SECTION 2. The Report shall assess the impacts of the Initiative pursuant to Elections Code section 9212 subsection (a)(1-8).

SECTION 3. The Report shall be presented to the City Council at its October 24, 2025 Regular Meeting.

PROHIBITION ON CONCENTRATED ANIMAL FEEDING OPERATIONS (CAFOs)

The People of the City of McFarland ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

That Chapter 17.200 Prohibition on Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs) be added to Title 17 Zoning of the McFarland Municipal Code as follows:

Chapter 17.200 Prohibition on Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFOs)

17.200.010 Findings

- A. The residents of the City of McFarland value healthy communities including having safe drinking water.
- B. The State of California Water Quality Control Board adopted guidelines and regulations to provide for the control and reduction of salt and nitrates from degrading water quality within the Central Valley.
- C. In February of 2025, the Central Valley Water Quality Control Board conditionally approved the Kern Water Collaborative Early Action Plan (Early Action Plan) as one of the cornerstones of the Nitrate Control Program
- D. The Early Action Plan identifies Disadvantaged Communities as areas that lack adequate financial resources to treat for nitrate and other contaminants.
- E. The Early Action Plan identifies Confined Animal Feeding Operations as a specific source of nitrate production within the planning area.
- F. Existing Confined Animal Feeding Operations within the City limits of the City of McFarland are permitted by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board to house 3,553 animal equivalent units at the facility.
- G. Existing Confined Animal Feeding Operations within the City limits of the City of McFarland produce 14.7 million gallons of wastewater annually which contain high levels of nitrates and salts.
- H. The residents of the City of McFarland have experienced increase levels of nitrates in the drinking water system.
- I. The City of McFarland has taken steps to mitigate the increased nitrate levels on a temporary basis.
- J. The residents of the City of McFarland desire to reduce nitrate producing sources within the City limits of the City of McFarland.

17.200.020 Purpose.

The Purpose of this Section is to protect the environment and the health and well-being of McFarland residents and communities by prohibiting the operation of CAFOs, as defined herein, within the city limits of the City of McFarland.

17.200.030 Definitions.

The following words and phrases as used in this Chapter shall be defined as follows:

“Animal feeding operation” or **“AFO”** means a lot or facility that meets the regulatory definition of an AFO as set out by the Environmental Protection Agency in 40 CFR 122.23 as of August 2023. Specifically, a lot or facility (other than an aquatic animal production facility) is deemed an AFO where the following conditions are met:

- (i) Animals (other than aquatic animals) have been, are, or will be stabled or confined and fed or maintained for a total of 45 days or more in any 12-month period, and
- (ii) Crops, vegetation, forage growth, or post-harvest residues are not sustained in the normal growing season over any portion of the lot or facility.

“Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation” or **“CAFO”** means an AFO which meets the definition of a Small CAFO, Medium CAFO or Large CAFO, as defined herein, and set out by the Environmental Protection Agency in 40 CFR 122.23 as of August 2023, or which is designated as a CAFO of any size by the permitting authority.

“Large CAFO” means an AFO which confines at least the number of animals described in Table 17-0.

“Medium CAFO” means an AFO which falls within the size range in Table 18-0 and either:

- (i) has a man-made ditch or pipe that carries manure or wastewater to surface water;
or
- (ii) the animals come into contact with surface water that passes through the area where they’re confined; or
- (iii) is designated as a Medium CAFO by the permitting authority due to being a significant contributor of pollutants.

“Pre-Existing CAFO” means a CAFO currently in existence in City of McFarland at the time this Ordinance becomes effective.

“Small CAFO” means an AFO which confines fewer than the number of animals listed in Table 17-0 and which has been designated as a CAFO by the permitting authority as a significant contributor of pollutants.

17.200.040 Aggregation.

Two or more lots or facilities that collectively meet the definition of a CAFO shall together be deemed a CAFO if they are under common ownership and are either on adjoining parcels or share a waste disposal system.

17.200.050 Prohibition of CAFOs; Exceptions.

1. No person shall establish, operate, expand, or maintain a CAFO in the City of McFarland on or after the date of the enactment of this Section.
2. This Section does not limit or impact the availability of remedies under other applicable local, state and federal laws, regulations, and ordinances, including but not limited to laws, regulations, and ordinances regarding environmental protection and animal cruelty.
3. The prohibitions in this Section shall not apply to an evacuation area set up to temporarily stable animals in the case of a natural disaster or a declared state of emergency, or to a registered non-profit animal shelter, sanctuary, or rescue organization which does not sell animals or animal products.

17.200.060 Existing CAFOs; Phase-Out Period.

1. Notwithstanding anything in this Section, Pre-Existing CAFOs shall be deemed a nonconforming use and shall be required to register on a public database maintained by the City of McFarland.
2. Pre-Existing CAFOs shall be given a phase-out period of no more than twenty-four (24) months from the effective date of this Section to terminate their operations. Proof of this shall be provided to the City of McFarland prior to the end of the phase-out period. During the phase-out period, Pre-Existing CAFOs shall not increase the number of animals in confinement.
3. The City Manager or his/her designee shall inspect closed CAFOs within one month of receiving such proof of termination from a Pre-Existing CAFO to ensure that all relevant operations have ceased or been appropriately terminated.
4. Any Pre-Existing CAFO may apply to the City of McFarland for ninety (90) day extensions beyond the phase-out period identified in section E-2, provided that no more than two (2) extension periods are granted. The extensions would be in the form of a Conditional Use Permit and would include plans and phases for the termination of the pre-existing CAFO and may include the payment of exactions as determined by the City Council.

17.200.070 Violations.

1. Any person who continues to operate a Pre-Existing CAFO after the one (1) year phase-out period elapses (or any extension as provided in E4), or who establishes or maintains a CAFO following the enactment of this Section, or who violates any other provision of this Section, shall be subject to a civil penalty of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) for the first offense, five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for the second offense, and ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for the third and any subsequent offenses, payable to the City of McFarland General Fund.
2. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the City Manager or his/her designee may also pursue on behalf of the city any other civil or administrative penalty or remedy otherwise available for failure to comply with the requirements of this Section.
3. Each day, or portion thereof, during which the violation occurs shall be treated as a separate offense.
4. Nothing herein shall impact the standing of other interested parties, or the availability of remedies under other applicable federal, state and local laws, regulations and ordinances, including the remedies afforded by any person set forth in Subsection I of this Ordinance.
5. For the purposes of this Subsection (F), “person” includes any owner, officer, or director of a CAFO. No penalties shall be issued to individuals solely for working at a CAFO operation unless they also meet one of the foregoing criteria.

17.200.080 Annual Report.

The City Manager or his/her designee shall prepare an annual report containing the following information: the number of CAFOs currently operating in City of McFarland; the number of CAFO termination notices received in the previous year; the number of CAFO termination inspections conducted in the previous year; the number of CAFO workers in the retraining program; and the amount of penalties assessed and collected in the previous year. Such report shall be presented to the City Council at a duly-noticed public hearing and posted on the City’s webpage, beginning one year after the effective date of this Section and continuing until all CAFOs, as defined herein, have been phased out of the City.

17.200.090 Right of Action.

Any interested party may institute a civil proceeding for injunctive relief against a violation of this Section, and for whatever other additional relief the court deems appropriate. In any action brought pursuant to this Section, the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorney's fees and costs. The remedies available under this Section shall be in addition to, and shall not in any way restrict, any other rights or remedies under law. Nothing in this Section is intended to, or shall be interpreted to, conflict with the Constitution of the United States, the Constitution of the State of California, or with any state or federal law. For the purposes of this Section, "interested party" shall include but not be limited to any association, organization, society, or corporation organized for the purpose of protecting animals or the environment.

17.200.100 Retaliation Prohibited.

Any person who retaliates against another person for making a good-faith complaint that there has been a failure to comply with this Section is guilty of a misdemeanor.

17.200.110 Severability.

The provisions of this Section are declared to be separate and severable. The invalidity of any clause, phrase, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or portion of this Section, or the invalidity of the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Section, or the validity of its application to other persons or circumstances. In the event that any provision is severed, the remaining provisions of this Section shall be interpreted in light of its stated purpose and intent.

SECTION 2. FUTURE AMENDMENTS.

In addition to the foregoing, the City Council shall amend the City Municipal Code as needed within a reasonable time following the adoption of the Ordinance to effectuate this Ordinance, and from time-to-time as the necessity of any other amendments becomes clear.

SECTION 3. CONSTRUCTION & INTERPRETATION.

This Ordinance and its provisions shall be broadly construed and interpreted to accomplish its purpose and intent.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.

If any provision of this Ordinance, or part thereof, or the application of any provision or part to any person or circumstance is held for any reason to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions and parts shall not be affected, and the

Ordinance as a whole shall be interpreted in light of its stated Purpose and Intent. The People of the City of McFarland hereby declare that they would have passed this Ordinance and every section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be

declared unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval by the voters, or as soon as otherwise allowable under applicable law.

SECTION 8. CERTIFICATION; PUBLICATION.

Upon approval by the voters, the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published according to law.

SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution No. 2025-126 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MCFARLAND APPROVING A COMMUNITY GRANT TO THE COUGAR BOOSTER CLUB TO SUPPORT YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETIC EVENTS

SUMMARY:

In February 2023, the McFarland City Council established the Community Grants Program to support local groups, organizations, and volunteers dedicated to enhancing the cultural, social, and economic vitality of the city. The program provides funding opportunities for events and initiatives that directly benefit the community, with an emphasis on transparency, accountability, and equitable use of public funds. This initiative reflects the Council's vision of fostering impactful programs, services, and projects while maintaining fiscal responsibility.

On August 25, 2025, the Cougar Booster Club submitted a grant application requesting \$2,500 to support youth participation in several athletic events, including the McFarland Girl's Basketball Tournament and the Girl's Cross Country Tournament.

- The McFarland Girls' Basketball Team is scheduled to participate in a tournament in Folsom, California, from December 11–13, 2025. This event will provide student-athletes with the opportunity to compete at a higher level while continuing to develop their athletic skills.
- Similarly, the McFarland Girls' Cross Country Team is planning to participate in several tournaments throughout the season, including:
 - Woalbridge Invite – September 19–20, 2025
 - Portland Blue Lake Park Invitational (Oregon) – September 24–26, 2025
 - Agent A. Flores Memorial Invite – October 3–4, 2025
 - CIF State Championship – November 29, 2025

The total cost of participation in these events is estimated at \$7,500. The Cougar Booster Club is requesting \$2,500 from the City's Community Grants Program, with the remaining balance to be raised through community fundraising efforts. The requested funds would help reduce financial barriers and ensure broader access for students to participate in these enriching athletic and academic experiences.

This report evaluates the grant request based on the program's established criteria, including its alignment with public service goals and the promotion of community health, safety, and welfare. Approval of this grant would allocate funding from the City's annual budget designated for community support initiatives.

Endorsing this grant request represents a meaningful investment in McFarland's youth, encouraging civic engagement, skill development, and pride in community representation. The anticipated outcomes include long-term benefits in social development, educational enrichment, and strengthened community identity.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the application's alignment with the Community Grants Program criteria and the potential impact on McFarland's youth and broader community, staff recommends approval of the Cougar Booster Club's grant request. This funding will not only support local athletes in their development but will also reinforce McFarland's commitment to nurturing a strong, vibrant community through engagement in educational and athletic pursuits.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MCFARLAND APPROVING A COMMUNITY GRANT TO THE COUGAR BOOSTER CLUB TO SUPPORT YOUTH PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETIC EVENTS

WHEREAS, the City of McFarland recognizes the importance of community-based groups, organizations, and volunteers in enhancing the cultural, social, and economic well-being of the city; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of McFarland established the Community Grants Program in February 2023 to provide funding opportunities for events and activities that contribute positively to the community; and

WHEREAS, the Community Grants Program is designed to ensure that tax dollars are expended in a manner that is justifiable, fair, and holds recipient groups accountable for their spending, thereby demonstrating the City Council's commitment to supporting beneficial programs, services, or projects; and

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2025, the Cougar Booster Club submitted an application for a community grant to assist with expenses related to youth participation in a series of athletic events, including tournament in Folsom, California, Woalbridge Invite, Portland Blue Lake Park Invitational (Oregon), Agent A. Flores Memorial Invite, and the CIF State Championship; and

WHEREAS, the Cougar Booster Club's proposed project supports the expansion of extracurricular academic and athletic programs at McFarland High School Early College, with a focus on providing access to students who may face financial barriers to participation; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost for attendance and participation in these events is \$7,500, with the commitment to raising the remaining funds through community fundraising efforts; and
